Higashi Agatsuma-machi is one of the country's premier daffodil production sites. From early to mid-April, the whole town turns almost all yellow. The area next to the Iwai Shinsui Koen Park has 300,000 daffodils. Right beside it, one-kilometer road is lined with cherry trees, making ideal scenes for photographers. During the festival period, raffles, sale of daffodils, and other events will be offered.

Senbonzakura means 1,000 cherry trees. Located at the foot of Mt. Akagiyama, the place literally offers 1,000 cherry trees in full bloom on both sides of a 1.3-km sloping road. Trees will be lit up in the evening. Alongside it are the sprawling yellow Nanohana field mustards. During the festival period, food stands of all variety will be set up.
